A record breaking level of attendance for our 8th edition is proof that a real awareness of the ecological challenges of our time persists within our profession. With over 420 films submitted from 5 continents worldwide, the industry has shown a true commitment to the fight for a more sustainable future.

### WINNERS 2019

On Thursday, 13th of June 2019, one hundred finalists were awarded prestigious Gold and Silver Green Awards at our 8th annual award giving ceremony in Deauville. In addition, 14 Special Prizes and 3 Grand Prix were given to those who excelled in their thematic categories and competitions, making a particular impression on our prestigious international jury.

#### **The 3 Grands Prix:**

**SPOT Competition:** *“Aucune femme ne mérite de vivre dans la peur”* by Pascal Couvry from Madam Bovary for the “Une femme, un toit” association about violence against women

**INFO Competition:** *“La station service”* about the announced collapse of our modern consumerist societies, a series by Et Bim for Canal +

**DOCU Competition:** *“Rhino Dollars”* documentary produced by TV Presse for Arte and directed by Olivia MokieJewski on the workings of global ivory trafficking

#### **Category Prizes:**

Gold and Silver Green Awards were awarded to the best films in each competition and their 14 thematic categories.

#### **14 Special Prizes:**

The **KapaGama** Special Prize for Best Music was awarded to “A Beautiful Summer”

The **TF1 Initiative** Special Prize was awarded to “The Condor & The Eagle”

The **Bpifrance** Special Prize was awarded to “Green Lion” and “Isahit” out of dozens of startups that mobilised to film their high impact initiatives.

The Special Prize for our **#FilmeTaBiodiversité** Competition for 15-25 year olds was awarded to young Normandy residents for their commitment.

The **Deauville Green Awards Special Prize** was awarded to “After-tomorrow” by Cyril Dion (director of the world famous documentayry « Tomorrow »).

The festival gave the floor to Cyril Dion and Magali Payen (coordinators of the # OnEstPrêt youtube collective) to present their "Resist and Create" project, emphasizing the key role of film producers in initiating dialogue and inspiring change!
